



Go Basic Rules

Step 1.

Two players take alternating turns placing their pieces, called “stones” starting with black, on the empty intersections lines called “Points” of the playing board (typically 9×9, 13×13, or the standard sized 19×19 grid).

Step 2.

Liberties & Capturing – If a player surrounds an opposing stone or stones by playing on all adjacent points called “liberties,” those opposing stone(s) are captured and removed from the board.
